

SURGERY DAY DRIVER INSTRUCTIONS

Please Read Carefully

Thank you for being the responsible adult driver today. For patient safety and smooth discharge, please follow the instructions below.

You Will Receive **2** Phone Calls Today

1 First Phone Call – Surgery Complete

You will receive a phone call from our office to inform you that:

- The surgery is complete.
- The patient is in recovery.
- You may return your vehicle to the parking lot at that time.

Please ensure your phone is on and the ringer volume is turned up.

2 Second Phone Call – Ready for Discharge

You will receive a second phone call when:

- The Registered Nurse (RN) has completed recovery.
- The patient is ready to be discharged.

At that time, we ask that you:

1. Pull your vehicle up to the front of the building.
2. Park parallel to the sliding glass doors.
3. Remain in your vehicle.
4. Wait for the RN to bring the patient out to you.



Important Reminders

- Please remain within close driving distance of the office.
- Keep your phone accessible at all times.
- If you miss our call, return it immediately.
- The patient must be discharged into the care of a responsible adult.
